Please encourage your child to work independently when appropriate. While your child will need supervision and support, they should be completing the green assignment booklets as independently as possible in order to gain an accurate assessment of their abilities.

Most of my evaluation will be in the form of anecdotal comments as these will be the most beneficial in addressing your child's individual learning strengths and challenges. Progress report cards will be mailed three times throughout the school year, however, parents are encouraged to maintain regular contact (i.e. monthly) regarding their child's progress.

I use the following checklist to help students learn criteria for quality work:

Give Me 5

1.	Complete - No activities have been missed	
2.	Neat - Writing is neat and a ruler is used for drawing lines	
3.	Timely - Work has been completed on or close to due date	
4.	Independent - There is ample evidence that the student has completed most of the work independently	
5.	Correct - Most of the questions have been correctly answered
